Wachau



The Wachau is an Austrian enological zone in central Europe. More precisely, it is located in the subzone of Lower Austria. Since 2000 the Wachau is listed as World Heritage sites. In total, the Wachau is made up of about 1344 hectares of vineyards, including the cities of Melk and Spitz.

One of the determining factors of the landscape, but above all, of the quality of the wines produced here, is the presence of the Danube. The river is not only capable of reflecting the light and the heat in the cold months, but also helps to mitigate the temperatures in the colder season. As well as this aspect of fundamental importance, it is necessary to note that in the Wachau different


climatic aspects intersect each other (it is a generally continental climate with fresh winds from the Pannonia). The result is an alternation of warm and dry days with cool nights.

The geology of the area is rather varied, even if the most common structures are loam, kaolin, and gneiss. The terrain is very steep, so much so that often it must be terraced.

The principal varieties cultivated in the Wachau are:

• **Grüner Veltliner**: white berry married with the Traminer and not related to the Roter Veltliner or the Frühroter Veltliner. With reference to all Austrian vineyard soil, the Grüner Veltliner occupies 29% of the total surface. This grape

tends to produce a lot; therefore, it must be kept in check, by the vineyard.

• **Riesling**: late white berry that is not related to the Welschriesling. In the Austrian territory, the Riesling does not occupy many hectares, making up 4% of the land. However, in the Wachau, is the second most important grape in the area. Generally, in the cantina, these two varietals are fermented naturally in large barrels so old that they do not give up anything in terms of aromas, taste, or tannins.

Since the mid-1980s, most of the vintners are members of the regional association, called Vinea Wachau, that used its own classification system, divided into three categories: Steinfeder, Federspiel, and Smaragd.

Steinfeder: the name is derived from a type of grass that grows abundantly in the vineyards of the area. This type includes light wines, in which the alcohol grade never exceeds 11.5%.

Federspiel: the name comes from the practice of falconry and the hunting of a particular falcon that was very common in centuries past. The wines have an alcohol grade between 11.5 and 12.5%.

Smaragd: this category derives its name from a lizard of emerald color that is often encountered in among the vineyards of the area. It regards strong, rich, and complex wines that in many cases manage to age well for decades.

Nice, expressing fruit in this involving, fulfilling Grüner version. Its nose opens on white-pulped fruit, mango and papaya. It stretches in the mouth in a kaleidoscopic of sensations whose basis remain thickness and palate richness.

Another massive release. Its nose is citrusy, taut and vertical, with notes of grapefruit and chinotto, iodine at the end. The mouth is fresh, saline and spicy, deep and compact. Great persistence.

This is a delicate interpretation of the varietal. Its nose reveals white-pulped peach, pineapple, a hint of lemon zest. It tastes very juicy, compact and complex. The finish is taut, herbaceous and harmonic.

WEINGUT ROMAN GRITSCH

A very refined nose, playing between candied citron, yellow plum and closing with officinal trace, on the notes of thyme. Taut, compact and salty mouth. Fruity touch reappearing on the finish that it has also a charming almond touch.

WEINGUT GRUBER WACHAU

A new, impressive, organic release still in the vat. Chinotto and apricot on the nose, displaying a complex texture of yellow flowers in the final olfactory profile. Crunchy and taut mouth with extraordinary firmness. Citrusy trace returning on the finish.

WEINGUT ROMAN GRITSCH

A taut version coming from a winery that dates back even to '600. Its nose is of astonishing freshness, white pepper and persimmon notes, with a balsamic touch at the end, evergreen resin. Crunchy in the mouth, backed by a nice and sharp acidity.

WEINGUT SIG

Greatly vigorous sharpness in this Riesling version. Its nose does not reveal only flowery notes, but also yellow tropical fruit and undergrowth ones. The mouth highlights a strong minerality. The finish is sharp, direct and intense.

WEINGUT JÄGER

A cornerstone from the Achleiten vineyard, both sharp and clean. Fruity nose of apricot, vegetal notes, rosemary. The palate is well defined and balanced with a closing of long persistence.





Greatly vigorous sharpness in this Riesling version. Its nose reveals white peach, spices and a definite herbaceous tone, with white flowers notes at the end. Freshness on the palate ending with aromatic and officinal herbs.

WEINGUT JAGER

A fresh, full-bodied vintage from a sixty-year-old vineyard. Unique tautness on the nose, with pink grapefruit, yellow-fleshed nectarine and a beautiful officinal trace from fresh laurel. It has a long persistence and balsamic and comforting notes in the finish.

WEINGUT JOHANN DONABAUM

Grapes from both 'top' locations Offenberg and Setzberg, with a small percentage of Botrytis Cinerea-affected berries, at the nose persimmon, kiwi and a bit of fresh sage, with a balsamic touch at the end. Crunchy in the mouth, backed by a nice and sharp acidity.

WEINGUT ROMAN GRITSCH

Its nose reveals lemon, apricot and white-pulped peach, and closing with officinal trace, on the notes of rosemary, whereas its mouth presents a strong sharpness and a beautiful spiciness. Fresh, taut, savoury, with citrus trace on the finish.

Intense straw yellow, deep and taut nose with nuances of pink grapefruit and kiwi. Excellent crispness in the mouth with salinity and persistence. Citrusy notes returning on the long-lasting finish.

Its nose reveals white peach, spices - dried rosemary - and a definite herbaceous tone, while its mouth is clearly mineral, sapid and greatly juicy.

Its nose reveals golden apple at top, but it is also herbaceous and spicy, whereas the mouth is of great compactness and full-bodied. The vigorous tension leads to a taut and mineral finish.
